

Students New to School Town of Munster

1. High ability services and program identification are determined locally. Students coming to School Town of Munster from another district will be required to meet the STM high ability criteria to be enrolled as a high ability student.
2. Standardized test data from the sending district may be submitted to the Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum and Instruction for review. In the event that the sending school's documentation does not support placement into high ability, students in grades 6-11 may participate in testing provided by the district prior to registration (\$60 fee). Testing will occur July 24-28, 2017, only. To participate, email plhowarth@munster.us prior to July 3, 2017.
3. Students new to School Town of Munster and enrolled in grades 3, 4, 6 and 7 will take the InView in the spring of their first year in the district. This is done to provide the district with consistent and valid data that will be used to determine appropriate high ability placement. This information, in conjunction with performance on NWEA during the winter assessment window, will determine high ability placement for the following school year.
